 - Individual \$813Family \$1,839

 - Fam+65/-65 \$1,639
 - Fam Both +65 \$1,439

- Medicare Discount Under the EEHP
 - 2006/07 Discounted Rates put in place for Medicare Prime Retirees
 - Initial Discount was \$50 for Ind & \$100 for Fam +2
 - Discounts Have Steadily Increased to \$200 for Ind & \$400 for Fam +2 in 2013/14
